<u>Emergency contact</u>: Joe Maldonado (414) 339-4574. Camp phone number: (262) 327-8444. Cell phone coverage may be limited.

<u>Who should attend</u>: Teams of high school-age youth (ages 14-18) young adults (18-21) and adults (21 or older) who share decision-making roles in communities, schools and organizations. Groups are limited to 10 people with a preferred ratio of four youth to each adult.

<u>Accommodations</u>: The conference maximizes the camp atmosphere with a mixture of learning, fun and connection-building activities. Workshops and activities are hosted in informal meeting rooms, the lodge hall and the dining area.

<u>Overnight lodging</u>: Heated cabins. Up to 24 youth per cabin. Screened adult volunteers will stay in a separate area within youth cabins; other adults will be in all-adult dorms. Members of teams will be blended with other teams in cabins to promote fellowship.

<u>What to Bring</u>: Bedding is needed–a pillow, sleeping bag or sheets/blankets, towel, toiletries, flashlight. For open stage–bring hand musical instruments (guitar, fiddle...), poetry, etc.

<u>Supervision</u>: Male or female adult chaperones sleep in the common areas in cabins between units with bed checks throughout the nights. Teams are asked to designate an adult to help with supervision (this person needs to complete a Chaperone Expectation Statement.)

<u>Special Accommodations</u>: University of Wisconsin-Extension provides equal opportunities in employment and programming, including Title IX and ADA requirements. Please request reasonable accommodations to ensure equal access to the conference before the registration deadline.

# **Directions to Turning Rivers**

## Address: N885 Youth Camp Road, Campbellsport, WI 53010

### **Directions from Milwaukee (South of Turning Rivers**

- Head north on US Hwy 41/45
- At the Hwy 41/45 split, stay right towards West Bend and remain on Hwy 45
- Follow Hwy 45 into the town of Kewaskum (signs will say "freeway ends")
- Continue on US-45 North/Fond du Lac Ave.
- Turn right onto Main Street and take this for .4 miles and turn left onto Riverview Dr/County Road S (County Road S turns into G) Remain on this road for 4.5 miles.
- Turn Right on Youth Camp Road and to follow to camp entrance 1.1 Miles.
- Camp is on your left marked by a camp sign.

#### From the Fond du Lac Area (North of Turning Rivers)

- Follow Hwy 41 South to the Campbellsport Exit, Hwy 67
- Follow Hwy 67 to and through Campbellsport (pay close attention as Hwy 67 turns throughout the village)
- Follow 67 out of Campbellsport to Hwy 45
- Turn right on Hwy 45 (South)
- Follow Hwy 45 South to Auburn Ashford Road (watch carefully for sign)
- Turn left onto Auburn Ashford and follow to point where it dead ends into Hwy G
- Turn left and follow Hwy G to Youth Camp Road
- Turn right onto Youth Camp Road and travel one mile to entrance of camp on left

### From the Madison Area (West of Turning Rivers)

- Follow straight onto US-151 N/E Washington Ave
- Continue to follow US-151 N
- Take exit 132 for WI-33 E toward Beaver Dam/Horicon
- Turn right onto State Hwy 33 Trunk E/WI-33 E
- Turn left onto Main St
- Turn right onto E Lake St
- Turn left onto WI-28 E/Clason St
- Continue to follow WI-28 E
- Turn left onto Co Rd TW
- Turn left onto Co Rd Y
- Turn right onto County Rd T West
- Sharp left onto US-45 N
- Turn right onto Auburn Ashford Dr
- Turn left onto Co Rd G
- Turn right onto Youth Camp Rd
